KNITTING NEEDLES ARE US!

The difficult situation with knitting needles is over here at Butler's Country Knit Shop. We have needles in almost all sizes except #19, which is still in short supply.

Why, you ask, is that one size hard to get? Well, we can get it in plastic and metal, but the material most knitters want these days is bamboo, and that's where the trouble is. The diameter of the #19 needle is just too big for existing stocks of the material. We will be getting #19s in Birch however, and most of our knitters say they're very nice and about the same feel as bamboo.

Speaking of needles, We are enlarging our selection of Addi Turbo needles. They're the ones preferred by speed knitters, mostly using the Continental knitting method, and they're made in Germany by the Skacel Company. Turbos are all circular needles and they slip the stitches very easily, so if you are already having trouble with stitches slipping off the needles *when you don't want them to*, perhaps Addi Turbo needles wouldn't be quite the things for you.

THE END OF AN ERA
